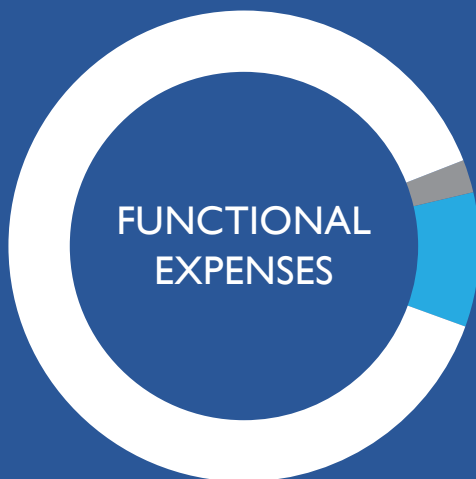

OUR MISSION

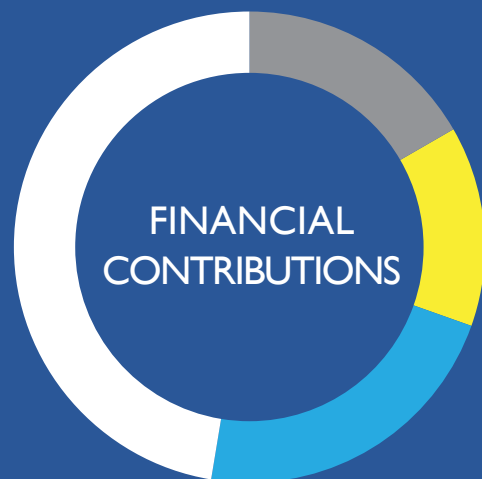
